All Hunters

- 1 pair Wool Trousers – Heavy for Cold Seasons)
- 1 Warm Coat or Parka
- 2 Hats – Stocking Cap and Brimmed or Western
- 2 pair Jeans
- 2 sets Thermal Underwear
- 2 Shirts – Wool or Flannel (Colder Hunts)
- 2 Shirts – Lightweight, Cotton, etc. (Warmer Hunts)
- 6 pair Warm Socks
- 2 pair Boots (Insulated, Waterproof & Lightweight)
- 1 set **Quality** Rain Gear – "Quiet" as Possible
- 2 pair Warm Waterproof Gloves
- Compact Flashlight & Extra Batteries
- Binoculars and/or Spotting Scope
- Rangefinder * & Extra Battery
- Knife
- Unbreakable Canteen
- Waterproof Matches
- Emergency "Space" Blanket

Summer Trips

Quality hiking boots (with low heels for horseback riding) and comfortable clothing help make your trip more enjoyable. Bring sunscreen, brimmed hat, a windbreaker and a medium-light jacket or sweatshirt for breezy days and cooler night air, fishing equipment & tackle as needed (license required).

Archery Hunters

Substitute the appropriate clothing in the left column with camouflage in green, gray & brown patterns.

Camouflage Make-up or Head Netting / Veil
Hard Bow Case during Travel
Bow Scabbard or Bow Sling – Horseback Riding
Tackle Box with:

- Extra Bow String
- Compound Bow Stringer
- Needle Nose Pliers
- Allen Wrench Set (as Needed)
- Extra Peep Sight
- Spare Release
- Extra Broadheads

Broadheads (Suitable for Game Hunted –
12-18 Arrows **Minimum Weight 300 grains**)
Capped PVC Tube or Hard Arrow Transport Case
Practice Arrows & Tips (Same Weight Being Used)

Cougar Hunters

The nature of this hunt demands layering your clothing. Sub-zero temperatures and winter conditions are to be expected during this season. Bring a day pack capable of holding extra clothing as you layer up and down throughout the day. High quality clothing and boots are essential to keeping you comfortably warm and dry. If you already own snowshoes, you may bring them. Waterproof knee high gaiters will help keep your boots and legs dry.

All Clients

Personal items such as toothbrush, towel, handkerchief, camera, prescriptions or OTC medications (as needed). There is a weight limit of 120# (1 pack animal) for Summer Pack Trips and Guided Hunts, 180# (1 ½ pack animals) for Drop Camps and Semi-guided Hunts per person – **excluding your Rifle or Bow**. Pack your gear and/or supplies in duffel bags, coolers, or hard cases of approximately equal size and weight. We provide rifle scabbards and saddle bags – You may bring your own if you prefer.
